MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING (1/5)

The former Chair, Tim Fell, welcomed attendees to the AGM. 24 attendees in-person at Guides Hall, Coram's Fields. 31 attendees via Zoom. The panel were able to see questions raised by those attending via a Q&A box and a live commentary feed, allowing people to comment and chat.

Motion: THAT, the Minutes of the 2020 AGM dated 10 October 2020 at 1pm held on Zoom stand as read. Proposed by Roy Trankle, seconded by Betony Kelly. For: 36, Against: 0, Abstained: 12.

FINANCE REPORT

Gary Barth took the meeting through the organisation's 2020 accounts with a review of our 2021 finances and reserves policy. Jane Powell, CEO, followed up with slides showing the staffing at STAMMA and responsibilities and how the expenditure is allocated to our services.

Motion: THAT, the AGM accepts the Finance Report: Proposed by Betony Kelly, seconded by Velda Osborne. For: 32, Against: 1, Abstained: 1.

MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING (2/5)

OFFICE REPORT

Jane Powell set out the strategic goals set in 2018 and talked through how the organisation was progressing with each of these. She ended by talking through the ambitions for 2022:

- Next year, we host STAMMAFest Global (24th-28th August) in Liverpool. Tickets for this should be available from January 2022. Ticket prices yet to be decided.
- The staff team will be joined by Catherine Woolley in January, so we can extend our support for families, parents of children who stammer and young people.
- The recruitment of Catherine will allow Kirsten to focus on the helpline and our support for those who stammer looking for work/progressing in work.
- We want to build our corporate supporter list.
- We need to increase income from members vis a vis fundraising and donations.

Motion: THAT, the AGM accepts the CEO Report: Proposed by Naheem Bashir, seconded by Neil Morjaria and Christine Simpson. For: 35, Against: 0, Abstained: 1.

MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING (3/5)

AUDITORS

Derek Maynard proposed Royce Peeling Green be retained as auditors for 2022, seconded by Sibon Phiri.

Motion: THAT, Royce Peeling Green Limited is appointed as the Charity's auditor to hold office with immediate effect to the end of the next period for appointing auditors under section 485(2) of the Companies Act 2006, at a remuneration determined by Trustees. Proposed by Derek Maynard, seconded by Sibon Phiri. For: 35, Against: 0, Abstained: 13.

TRUSTEE ELECTION & BOARD COMPOSITION

Tim Fell thanked Sibon Phiri for her year on the Board replacing Abed Ahmed who had stepped down. He reported that the Board had invited Gillian Rudd and Naheem Bashir to serve a further three years. Chantal Anderson and Rhian Binns had come top in the Trustee Elections.

Motion: THAT, Rhian Binns and Chantal Anderson are appointed as the elected trustees of the Charity. Proposed by Derek Maynard, seconded Christine Simpson. For: 36, Against: 1, Abstained: 10.

Tim reported that the Board had elected Joanna Gaukroger for the next three years.

MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING (4/5)

VISION & MISSION

The Trustees proposed the following amended vision and mission:

VISION

A world where stammering is embraced, included and represented, and where people feel at ease with stammering.

MISSION

To lead a movement to change how the world views stammering, while supporting and empowering people who stammer. To:

- Campaign for the right to be heard
- Inspire, encourage, inform and support all people who stammer
- Dispel myths and misconceptions
- Challenge discrimination
- Inform and educate the public
- Promote and support self help
- Support a culture of openness about stammering
- Inform those seeking therapy about the options available to them
- Support parents, family, friends and colleagues of people who stammer
- Encourage, collate and comment on research
- Share knowledge and new ideas.

MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING (5/5)

AOB

The meeting closed with a speech from TimFell, who reinforced his desire to see STAMMA remain a broad church for everyone who stammers, whether they want to control and manage their stammer or whether they are proud of how they talk, and to see recognition of the importance of access to speech and language therapy.

Joanna thanked Tim for his years of service to BSA/STAMMA and presented him with two engraved Waterford glasses from the Board. This gift was followed with a bottle of single malt whisky from the staff.

APPOINTMENT OF AUDITORS

- The audit of the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2021 was performed by Royce Peeling Green Limited ('RPG')
- As in the previous year, it was agreed by the Trustees that RPG would perform a full audit, rather than just an independent review of the nature performed up to 2019.
- It is proposed that RPG be re-appointed to perform the audit for the year ended 31 December 2022

2022 – FINANCIAL REVIEW

Over 2022 we have continued taking steps to carry out our 2018 5-year plan. With stronger financial reserves in place following legacies received in 2020 and reserves established in 2021, the financial position of STAMMA continues to remain positive. Key developments this year include:

- Our conference has been run for the first time in three years
- We have moved to new premises in central London to improve accessibility
- We are continuing to work with a specialist Grants Officer in order to obtain more grant income and build fundraising through our membership.
- Legacy income of around £55,000 has been received during the year, with further legacies expected over the next few months.

Our budget for 2022 planned for increased income and expenditure compared to 2021, with STAMMAFest Global having a significant impact on this. A net cash outflow for the year of around £44k was forecast, with the aim being the conference would break even. We expect results for the year ending 31 December 2022 to be consistent with our budget for the year.

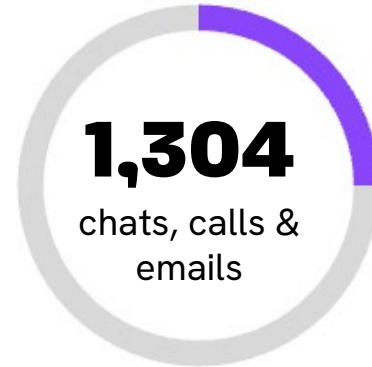

Our extended support is anything from liaising with the courts, schools or employers or providing time to practice calls.



Employment Service

Advising companies like TPP Recruitment, HMRC and Islington Council; delivering workshops for HR professionals & employers; helping individuals access reasonable adjustments for job interviews and at work.

Family Support

We've run **8 workshops** for parents of children who stammer and **14 Parent to Parent groups** since Nov 21, with 349 people registering.

Advocacy

Challenging large organisations to improve services for people who stammer and reduce discrimination.

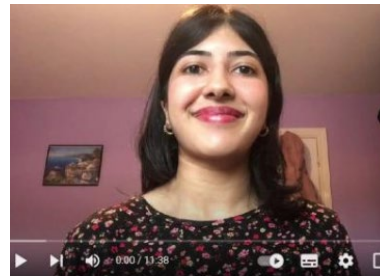
